An active member of Colorado Council of Mediators and Mediation Organizations (CCMO), Trish was largely responsible for establishing May as Colorado Mediation Month in 1993, and is currently the Chair of CCMO's Professional Mediator Committee. Regular involvement with local and national ADR, bar, and speaker associations helps Trish to keep ideas fresh and new techniques flowing. A diverse background combined with her substantial professional mediation experience provides students with a broad and realistic insight into the world of mediation – its many benefits, and its many challenges. Trish's hands-on, light-hearted teaching approach creates an open, constructive learning environment in which participants can absorb and practice key concepts and skills. They complete the training with a strong understanding of the professional mediation world and a greater degree of confidence with which to implement the skills in their own professional lives.
